Administration

1. Mr. John Reynolds opened the meeting and reviewed the agenda. Ms. Molly Mooney performed roll call. A request to receive an update on the work being done regarding winter peak loads was raised. PJM mentioned that work including modifications to the spline relationship in the winter is currently being done and results will be shared when analysis is complete. A request to review summer peaks to date was also received. PJM mentioned that there have been a few hot days to date this summer but hot weather has not been widespread throughout the PJM footprint with storms dampening potential peaks.
2. The Load Analysis Subcommittee reviewed and approved the draft minutes from the December 18, 2016 meeting. No changes were requested. Minutes will be posted as final.

Load Forecast Development

3. IHS Distributed Solar Generation Forecast

Ms. Bridgid Cummings reviewed draft assumptions pertaining to the long term forecast of distributed solar generation for the PJM region. Assumptions including federal and state policies, net energy metering (NEM) policies, and solar costs were reviewed. Stakeholders were asked to share comments, questions and feedback with PJM by August 21st to load_analysis_team@pjm.com so that assumptions can be finalized with IHS.

4. End-Use Variable Revisions

Mr. Andrew Gledhill presented changes to the end-use variables based on state-level equipment saturation rates. The EIA's 2009 Residential Energy Consumption Survey (RECS) has some state level data, which will be leveraged to benchmark the end-use inputs in the Load Forecast model. A number of comparison charts for equipment classes were shown that illustrate the percentage of households using the division data and state data along with a chart showing the total impact on the forecast.

5. 2017 Mid-Year Load Forecast Update

Mr. Andrew Gledhill reviewed the mid-year forecast update that included updates to economics, weather years, and used end-use data that did not include the Clean Power Plan (CPP). This mid-year update process started in 2012 and is done to provide RPM participants an indication of how the next load forecast will move. It is not used for any planning or market purposes. PJM was asked to post the economic data series used in the recent mid-year load forecast update.

Special Presentation

6. AEP's Price Elasticity Study

Mr. Chad Burnett, AEP presented results of a study to estimate the load response to price changes for Residential, Commercial, and Industrial customers in the AEP service territory. The relationship between price and usage was studied and results shared for each customer class.
