Release Notes <u>eDART XML Schemas</u>



Revisions to the *pro forma* Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) and the Commission's regulations under the Federal Power Act to improve accuracy and transparency of electric transmission line ratings.

- Impacts eDART TERM Application and pjm.com OASIS thermal ratings reports
- eDART 881 Train Implementations
 - Q4/2023: TO XML uploads and supporting downloads
 - Q4/2024: Additional eDART enhancements
- Compliance due July 2025



- ••New Transmission Outage Cause type added: RTU Outages
 - ••Planned Outage for a RTU which will make SCADA data unavailable for either part of or the entire station.
- ••Reminder that the Staging version of the Transmission Facility Outages List (linesout_new.txt) was updated in August 2024
