1. Welcome, reviewed agenda, PJM meeting guidelines, roll call and Anti-trust and Code of Conduct announcements – Mr. Fran Barrett and Mr. Jack Thomas.

(10:10 - 11:30) MEPETF Charter

Mr. Barrett and Mr. Thomas reviewed the current Market Efficiency Process Enhancement Task Force charter and the group determined no updates were needed to the charter to commence the planned new Phase 3 work.

(11:30 – 12:00) Next Steps

- 3. Mr. Barrett and Mr. Thomas facilitated discussions on next steps.
 - a. There was a request to record educational sessions and make the training available for future use. All material presented at stakeholder meetings remains available under the Meeting Materials section of the webpage. The MEPETF facilitation team will create an Educational Presentations section on the MEPETF webpage and store all past and upcoming training presentations in this section.
 - b. Education was requested on how PJM calculates benefits (energy and capacity, energy only and capacity only). It was requested to include specific use cases in the training.
 - c. Education was requested on Interregional Targeted Market Efficiency Projects (TMEP) and how it could be used for Regional Targeted Market Efficiency Projects (RTMEP).
 - d. There were questions around the inclusion of "Maybe able to support" in polls. Some felt it may give false indications of responders' intent. Polls do require to the responder to add comments if "Maybe able to support" is selected, but the comments may not provide enough detail. Facilitation team will investigate possible mitigation options.
 - e. It was discussed the task force would pursue how capacity benefits are handled in the benefits-to-cost calculations and the handling of historical congestion.
 - i. Questions were raised on if now was the correct time to deal with the capacity benefits issue, since PJM is awaiting FERC orders related to the capacity market. In response, some members said the FERC orders should not affect how the calculations are made, so the task force should continue to investigate the issue. It was also mentioned it would be good to give people more time to adapt to any changes, if made, to the benefits-to-cost calculations.





- ii. Concern was raised on the task force scope regarding the topic of historical congestion, since it was not a point of focus at the April 11, 2019 Planning Committee when the Committee endorsed pursuit and completion of Phase 3. The facilitator took the point under advisement. Upon review, it was determined that historical congestion was listed as an open concern in the posted presentation, so the group would move forward investigating the issue.
 - During the meeting Mr. Steve Huntoon offered to share materials he
 previously drafted regarding inclusion of historic congestion in models.
 After the meeting, Mr. Huntoon provided a document describing concerns
 he has with a RTMEP (intraregional) construct modeled after the TMEP
 (interregional) construct. This document was posted at the same time as
 the meeting minutes.

No New Items were raised. Stakeholders are invited to offer items for consideration under the approved Charter. The meeting was adjourned.
