Transmission Tariff

On August 26, 2021, as amended on October 8, 2021, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted amendments to Schedule 12-Appendix A of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) to incorporate cost responsibility assignments for two baseline transmission projects included in the recent update to the Regional Transmission Expansion Plan approved by the PJM Board of Managers on July 29, 2021. On October 8, 2021, PJM submitted a revised tariff record for OATT, Schedule 12- Appendix A- 15 to correct the project description for baseline upgrade b3317. PJM requests that the submittal be accepted for filing effective November 24, 2021.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2020), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective November 24, 2021, as requested.³

The filing in Docket No. ER21-2774-000 was publicly noticed on August 26, 2021, and an errata notice was issued on September 2, 2021, with interventions and protests due on or before September 27, 2021. The filing in Docket No. ER21-2774-001 was publicly noticed on October 8, 2021, with interventions and protests due on or before October 29, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2020)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against PJM.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2020).
