Reference: Definition of Working Credit Limit

On November 4, 2021, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted revisions to eliminate the duplicative definitions of Working Credit Limit in Attachment Q of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (Tariff) and consolidate the definition of Working Credit Limit into the Tariff, Part I Definitions section.¹

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2021), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective January 4, 2022, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before November 26, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2021)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made
