PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. West Penn Power Company Docket No. ER24-231-001

On October 27, 2023, as amended on October 30, 2023, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (PJM) submitted, on behalf of West Penn Power Company (West Penn), an amended Attachment H-11A to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff setting forth an Other Supporting Facilities Charge related to the use of West Penn's distribution facilities at voltages below 115 kV to provide transmission service to Allegheny Electric Cooperative, Inc. at certain designated delivery points.¹ West Penn requested that the submittal be accepted for filing effective October 30, 2023. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective, as requested.²

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.
